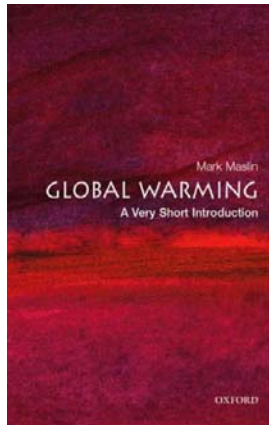


NEW BOOKS FROM THE BHRC
