

HUMANITARIAN RESPONSE TO NATURAL DISASTERS

The House of Commons International Development Committee published its report on Humanitarian response to natural disasters in November 2006. BUHRC's John Twigg was one of the expert witnesses called to give evidence to the Committee, on disaster risk reduction (DRR). In its report, the Committee called for greater investment in DRR by international donors.
